## MOTHER MARIE ANNE... AND OUR TIMES

I always enjoy experiencing the events of our time with Mother Marie Anne by my side, so to speak. It may be an occupational hazard of being a Sister, or it may be because my soul is deeply attached to hers. Her vision of things, her spirituality and her insight are all a part of me, which means that I view the events of the present time through her eyes.

### *The 375<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Ville-Marie (present-day Montreal)*

This is a grace-filled anniversary. When I first began preparing for this anniversary, some time ago, I was very moved at the apostolic zeal of Jérôme Le Royer de la Dauversière, the father of five natural children and one adopted child. He was at the very heart of the founding of Ville-Marie, filled with an ardent desire to spread the reign of God in a foreign land. A tax collector, he founded a pious and financial association, the Société de Notre-Dame, and managed to send to Canada the Sieur de Maisonneuve, a brilliant and zealous military man; Jeanne Mance, a nurse; and men intended to populate the colony, so that native peoples and the French could grow together in faith and charity. Braving the risks and perils of the ocean voyage, the “founders” of Ville-Marie disembarked on the banks of the St. Lawrence on May 17, 1642. Right away, in an improvised setting on the edge of the forest, Father Barthélemy Vimont, a Jesuit, celebrated the first Mass.

Three hundred and seventy-five years later, on May 17, 2017, at Notre-Dame Basilica in Montreal, a Mass composed by Pierre Grandmaison, titular organist at the Basilica, marked the event.

It spontaneously brought to my mind Mother Marie Anne’s offering of herself to go on mission to Vancouver after dreaming for so long of founding a “motherhouse on foreign soil”. The distances to be travelled were so great at the time that Vancouver could well seem to be “foreign soil”. In 1857, Bishop Modeste Demers called on the

Sisters of Saint Anne to come to Vancouver Island. The entire community, then consisting of 38 sisters, was willing to answer the call, including Mother Marie Anne! At age 48, already suffering from illness and pain, she made her offering for the mission in Western Canada. "I offered myself with all the sincerity of my soul, hoping that I would be granted this favour in spite of my unworthiness and my lack of ability; I later learned that those who would be sent out had been named. I resigned myself to God's holy will... The chief reason I wanted this mission was to strive for the Glory of God as much as I could, by making Him known to those poor children who had not yet had the joy of knowing Him..." (C.133-134)

When we take a closer look at the epic mystic and missionary journey of the Founders of Ville-Marie, it quickly becomes apparent that Mother Marie Anne was no stranger to this same apostolic zeal. As she wrote to her sisters on December 26, 1856: "Let us be faithful in little things, and we shall be found worthy to be so in the great; let us be religious who sacrifice, let us constantly turn a willing ear to the inspirations of grace... then God will be with us in time, and we with Him in eternity." (C.118-119) O Mother Marie Anne, help us to live in our times with the apostolic ardour and yearning for eternity that characterized you so well.

A ceremony was held on March 17, 2017, at Montreal City Hall to celebrate the occasion.
